In other news – Mayhem told Chopper something about Ernie going to the Drs for his ankle. Apparently it was really funny.

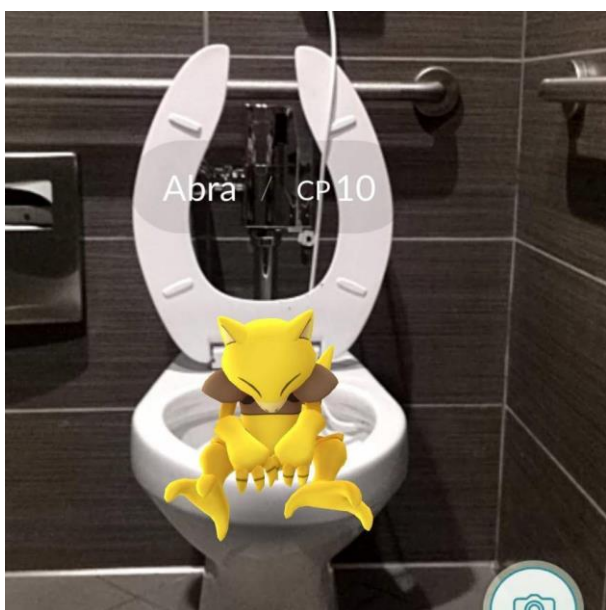
Gannet was overheard remarking about the cleanliness of the canal – she admitted to favouring it on the dirty side!
