

## **Advice for hares during Covid 19 restrictions**

### **Location**

- Choose a location for your Hash that is open, spacious and can accommodate social distancing between hashers.
- It may not be possible to car share, so more space than usual may be needed for car parking.
- Routes to be on open moorland or wide tracks where possible
- There should be minimal amount of gates or stiles on the route
- Choose places for checks with enough space for hashers to maintain social distancing.

### **At the start**

- The hare should ensure social distancing whilst signing hashers in.
- Money will be collected in a plastic container.
- Hashers will be told to bring the correct change so there will be no need to handle the money or give change.
- Do not collect hasher's keys, they will be responsible for their own keys.
- Hares are to remind all hashers to ensure social distancing and that hashers must contact a committee member if they have symptoms or test positive.
- Hares are to remind all hashers to use hand sanitiser (provided by committee) at the start and end of the hash if contact with gates/stiles etc is involved.
- If long and shorts start in same direction then long are to start ahead of shorts to allow for social distancing.
- Hash Hush will be at the start of the hash until further notice.

### **Mid hash**

- Hares may facilitate a regroup mid hash for safety reasons however this must be conducted in a Covid secure manner.

### **Check in at the end**

- Hares should again ensure social distancing when checking in.
- No drinks will be provided by the Hash.
- The box/bag of money and the hare list should be handed to Hash Cash or a committee member.
- Hares should encourage hashers to disperse promptly however should ensure that there are sufficient numbers for safety reasons should any hasher become lost or injured and require assistance.

If Hashers choose to stay behind to socialise after the hash it is entirely their own responsibility. There will be no formal on-downs until further notice.
